
Dear Mr. Byrd:

It has been determined that a permit will not be required under 45CSR13 for your proposed addition of a new vessel (AM98) for the temporary storage of ammonia while the existing ammonia storage tank (AM79) is taken out of service for cleaning. This also includes the removal of the #7 Dimethyl Amine Tank (AM55). This determination is based on information included with your permit determination form dated March 28, 2016 and received on April 8, 2016, which indicates that there will be no emissions increase of criteria pollutants. Additionally, there will be no increase in Hazardous Air Pollutants (HAPs); or, trigger a substantive requirement of any State or Federal air quality regulation. There will be no LDAR requirements as ammonia is not a HAP and Subpart Kb does not apply as it has a normal operating pressure above 204.9 kPa and does not have emissions to the atmosphere. It is recommended that you also update these changes in the Group 5 of 5 Title V Permit renewal.

Please bear in mind, however, that any additional changes to the proposed facility may require a permit under 45CSR13. Furthermore, pursuant to 45CSR13-5.14, records briefly describing the proposed change, the pollutants involved, the potential to emit for each pollutant increased or added shall be maintained by the owner or operator for at least two years and made available to the Director upon request.
