Dear Mr. Wicburg:

It has been determined that your proposed addition of three (3) electric compressors (in the aggregate called the Independence Compressor Station) co-located at the Oak Grove Gas Plant is not defined, pursuant to §45-13-2.17, as a “modification.” This determination is based on the information (including your emissions calculations) in your Permit Determination Form (PDF) submitted on July 23, 2015 that indicates that modification does not have reasonably calculated maximum emissions over two (2) lbs/hr OR five (5) tons/year of total Hazardous Air Pollutants (HAPs); six (6) lbs/hour AND ten (10) TPY or one hundred forty-four (144) pounds per calendar day of any regulated pollutant; or *trigger* a substantive requirement of any State or Federal air quality regulation.

Please be aware that any other changes may trigger the requirement to obtain a permit if the changes are defined as a “modification” under 45CSR13. Should you have any questions, please contact the undersigned engineer at (304) 926-0499 x1219.
