

## Public Notice 2017 Proposed Rules

The West Virginia Division of Air Quality has scheduled a public hearing for its 2017 proposed legislative rules on August 1, 2016 at the Division of Environmental Protection's Charleston headquarters, 601 57<sup>th</sup> Street S.E., Charleston, WV 25304. The public hearing will take place beginning at 6 p.m. in the Dolly Sods Conference Room. Oral and written comments will be limited to the proposed revisions and will be made a part of the rulemaking record.

Upon authorization and promulgation, rules 45C.S.R.16, 45C.S.R.25 and 45C.S.R.34 will be submitted to the EPA to fulfill federal obligations under the Clean Air Act, including delegations, plans, and program approvals. Upon authorization and promulgation of revisions to 45C.S.R.1, 45C.S.R.8, 45C.S.R.13, and 45C.S.R.14, the DAQ will submit the rules to the EPA as a revision to the State Implementation Plan pursuant to the federal Clean Air Act.
