

Heizer Compressor Station
Cranberry Pipeline Corporation**

Dear Director Durham:

Cranberry Pipeline Corporation (Cranberry) is pleased to submit this written request for a Class I Administrative Update to the existing Rule 13 permit to construct for the Heizer Compressor Station, located in Poca, Kanawha County, West Virginia. The Heizer Compressor Station currently operates under permit number R13-2694D and R30-07900046-2012. An original hard copy and two electronic copies (CD-ROM) of this written request are included with this submission.

Cranberry was issued permit R13-2694D from the WVDEP, Division of Air Quality (WVDAQ) on October 19, 2015. Cranberry submitted a class I administrative update on October 15, 2015 to request an update to R13-2694C. R13-2694C was submitted to receive the authority to construct a new stationary source, a White Superior 8GTLA Compressor Engine, rated at 1,100 hp. The permitting action also included the removal of the existing Clark HMB-8 compressor engine, rated at 440 hp, and the introduction of synthetic minor run hour and gas throughput limitations. Due to market conditions, Cranberry did not execute the capital expenditure project and therefore the original Clark HMB-8 compressor engine has remained at the station.

The class I administrative update submitted on October 15, 2015 requested that the WVDAQ remove the White Superior engine from the permit and re-permit the Clark compressor engine. Upon receipt of R13-2694D, Cranberry noted the presence of a



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permitting condition that was specific to the White Superior engine. With this permitting action, Cranberry requests that R13-2694D is updated to remove all references to the White Superior engine, which was not installed at the Heizer Station.

The permit condition that Cranberry requests changed with this class I administrative update includes Testing Requirement 4.2.2, which states:

Within 180 days of installation of the installation of the engine, the permittee shall perform testing of the White Superior Compressor Engine (2S) in accordance with Section 3.3.1 of this permit to determine compliance with the CO and NO_x emission limits of Section 4.1.1 of this permit."

Cranberry requests that this condition is replaced with a condition similar to Testing Requirement 4.2.1 of R13-2694D, and proposes the following language:

Within 180 days of installation of the issuance of this permit, the permittee shall perform testing of the Clark Compressor Engine (2S) in accordance with Section 3.3.1 of this permit to determine compliance with the CO and NO_x emission limits of Section 4.1.1 of this permit."
