BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Cranberry Pipeline Corporation is proposing to a facility to install a 1.5 MMBtu/hr natural gas fired pipeline heater at the above subject compressor station. The potential emissions are as follows:

RECOMMENDATION:

The emission rates are above the emission limits of six (6) lb/hr and ten (10) TPY; 2 lb/hr, or 5 TPY of HAPs set forth set forth in 45CSR13 - 2.17.a&b. Therefore, a permit is required by this Division for the pipeline heater at the facility.
