BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Reserve Oil & Gas, Inc. is proposing to install a small triethylene glycol (TEG) dehydration unit manufactured by Energy Weldfab. The installed model 125M12204PT comes with a reboiler rated at 125,000 Btu/hr and is designed to process a maximum of 1.0 million cubic feet of gas per day. The installation is not subject to Regulations 2, 10, 13, or Subpart HH. The potential emissions are as follows:

VOC	1.35	5.94
CO	0.02	0.07
NOx	0.02	0.09
HAPs	0.35	1.55

RECOMMENDATION:

The emission rates are below the emission limits of six (6) lb/hr and ten (10) TPY; 2 lb/hr, or 5 TPY of HAPs set forth set forth in 45CSR13 - 2.17.a&b. Therefore, a permit is not required by this Division for the dehydration unit installation.
