Subject: Administrative Update, R13-2694E, Cranberry Pipeline Corporation, Heizer Station

On October 16, 2015 the DAQ received an administrative update request for Cranberry Pipeline Corporation to make changes to Permit R13-2694C. Attached to this memo are the requested changes, letter of approval, and updated General Permit R13-2694E.

Class I updates may be administered in the event of typographical errors, which is why this application was submitted. In permit condition 4.2.2. of permit R13-2694D it stated:

Within 180 days of installation of the issuance of this permit, the permittee shall perform testing of the White Superior Compressor Engine (2S) in accordance with Section 3.3.1. of this permit to determine compliance with the CO and NOx emissions limits of Section 4.1.1.

This condition was changed to reflect the previously permitted and currently installed compressor engine, Clark Compressor Engine (2S). The permit condition 4.2.2. now reads:

Within 180 days of installation of the issuance of this permit, the permittee shall perform testing of the Clark Compressor Engine (2S) in accordance with Section 3.3.1. of this permit to determine compliance with the CO and NOx emissions limits of Section 4.1.1.
