
It has been determined that the relocation of methylene chloride emission sources are below the below the 6 lbs/hr and 10 tons per year or more, or more than 144 pounds per calendar day of any regulated air pollutant as required by 45CSR§13-2.17.a, 2 pounds per hour or 5 tons per year of hazardous air pollutants as required by 45CSR§13-2.17.b, or 10 percent (i.e. 500 lbs/yr) of the methylene chloride emissions as required by 45CSR§13-2.17.c. This determination is based on information included with your permit determination form dated December 9, 2015 and received on December 10, 2015, which indicates that there will an insignificant increase of 11.9 lbs/yr of VOC, 0.2 lbs/yr of methylene chloride, and 11.3 lbs/yr total HAP's; or, trigger a substantive requirement of any State or Federal air quality regulation.

The facility has a 0.04 tons per year limit of methylene chloride in Condition 5.1.2 of R13-2330G for the laboratory hoods (L001-L040) and a Best Available Technology "BAT" requirement in R13-2617I. If the facility wishes to remove these requirements since they dropped under the 5,000 lbs/yr methylene chloride threshold given in R13 Table 45-13A, they must submit a Class 1 Administrative Update for each Permit. The facility must also submit a minor modification to remove these same requirements from R30-10700001-2013 Part 13 of 14 Title V permit.

Please bear in mind, however, that any additional changes to the proposed facility may require a permit under 45CSR13. Furthermore, pursuant to 45CSR13-5.14, records briefly describing the proposed change, the pollutants involved, the potential to emit for each pollutant increased or added shall be maintained by the owner or operator for at least two years and made available to the Director upon request.
