





AIR QUALITY PERMIT NOTICE NOTICE OF THE INTENT TO APPROVE

On October 23, 2015, Mountain Valley Pipeline, LLC applied to the WV Department of Environmental Protection, Division of Air Quality (DAQ) for a permit to Construct a Natural Gas Compressor Station located near Flatwoods, Braxton County, WV at latitude 38.722500 and longitude -80.502817. A preliminary evaluation has determined that all State and Federal air quality requirements will be met by the proposed facility. The DAQ is providing notice to the public of its preliminary determination to issue the permit as R13-3279.

The following potential emissions will be authorized by this permit action: Particulate Matter less than 10 microns, 21.39 tons per year (TPY); Particulate Matter, 21.39 TPY; Oxides of Nitrogen, 86.73 TPY; Carbon Monoxide, 97.06 TPY; Volatile Organic Compounds, 13.99 TPY; Total Hazardous Air Pollutants, 4.79 TPY.

Written comments or requests for a public meeting must be received by the DAQ before 5:00 p.m. on Thursday, March 3, 2016. A public meeting may be held if the Director of the DAQ determines that significant public interest has been expressed, in writing, or when the Director deems it appropriate.

The purpose of the DAQ's permitting process is to make a preliminary determination if the proposed Construction will meet all State and Federal air quality requirements. The purpose of the public review process is to accept public comments on air quality issues relevant to this determination. Only written comments received at the address noted below within the specified time frame, or comments presented orally at a scheduled public meeting, will be considered prior to final action on the permit. All such comments will become part of the public record.

On November 30, 2015, Mountain Valley Pipeline, LLC (MVP) received a request to perform an aggregation analysis as a supplement to the construction permit application that is currently on file at the West Virginia Department of Environmental Protection (WVDEP). The requested aggregation analysis is included below.

Mountain Valley Pipeline, LLC (MVP) is a joint venture of affiliates of EQT Corporation (EQT), NextEra Energy, Inc., WGL Holdings, Inc., Vega Energy Partners, Ltd., and RGC Midstream, LLC. MVP will operate the proposed pipeline facilities and Harris compressor station (SIC code 4922).

There are no MVP facilities located adjacent to or contiguous to the proposed Harris Station. The closest MVP facility is the proposed Bradshaw Station, located approximately 55 miles away from the proposed Harris Station.


An affiliate of EQT is MVP's operating partner. There are no EQT facilities located adjacent to or contiguous to the proposed Harris Station. The nearest EQT facility is the Burnsville Compressor Station (SIC code 4922), located approximately 12 miles from the proposed Harris Station. The nearest EQT well pad (SIC code 1311) is located approximately 11 miles from the proposed Harris Station. Finally, it should be noted that operation of the Harris Station, Bradshaw Station, Burnsville Station, and the well pad is independent of one another. As such, the Harris Station should not be aggregated with any other facility.



Notice of Application

Notice is given that Mountain Valley Pipeline, LLC. has applied to the West Virginia Department of Environmental Protection, Division of Air Quality, for a construction permit (R-13) to construct a new natural gas transmission compressor station (Harris Station) located on County Route 24/5 eight miles east of Flatwoods in Braxton County, West Virginia. The site latitude and longitude coordinates are: 38.72251 N, - 80.50286 W.


The applicant estimates the potential increase in the following Regulated Air Pollutants associated with the project after the installation of the proposed equipment:

- Particulate Matter (PM) = 21.39 tpy
- Sulfur Dioxide (SO2) = 4.35 tpy
- Volatile Organic Compounds (VOC) = 13.99 tpy
- Carbon Monoxide (CO) = 97.06 tpy
- Nitrogen Oxides (NOx) = 86.73 tpy
- Hazardous Air Pollutants (HAPs) = 4.79 tpy
- Carbon Dioxide Equivalents (CO2e) = 180,861 tpy

Startup of operation will begin around the 4th quarter of 2017. Written comments will be received by the West Virginia Department of Environmental Protection, Division of Air Quality, 601 57th Street, SE, Charleston, WV 25304, for at least 30 calendar days from the date of publication of this notice.
