Dear Mr. Fehrenbacher:

It has been determined that a permit will not be required under 45CSR13 for your proposed addition of a new vessel (T6SJ) with a new stack (T6SJE) for your T6 area. This determination is based on information included with your permit determination form dated January 13, 2016 and received on January 14, 2016, which indicates that there will be an emissions increase of VOC's of 0.14 pounds per hour and 0.24 tons per year, which is less than the six pounds per hour and ten tons per year or more, or 144 pounds per day of criteria pollutant. Additionally, there will be no increase in Hazardous Air Pollutants (HAPs); or, trigger a substantive requirement of any State or Federal air quality regulation. It is recommended that you also update these changes in the R13-0815J and R13-3223 Permits during their next modifications, and update this change in the Part 2 of 14 Title V Permit renewal.

Please bear in mind, however, that any additional changes to the proposed facility may require a permit under 45CSR13. Furthermore, pursuant to 45CSR13-5.14, records briefly describing the proposed change, the pollutants involved, the potential to emit for each pollutant increased or added shall be maintained by the owner or operator for at least two years and made available to the Director upon request.
