BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Dominion Transmission, Inc. is proposing the installation of a natural gas fired emergency generator at the above subject facility. The generator set will be a Cummins Model KTA19G utilizing a 530 BHP @ 1,800 RPM engine that was manufactured in 2015.

The engine is a new source (constructed after June 12, 2006), located at an area source of HAPs, and is therefore subject to 40CFR63, Subpart ZZZZ (NESHAP). Due to the year of construction of the engine, it is not subject to a substantive requirement of that Federal Rule (e.g. no performance tests) but it must comply with 40CFR60 Subpart JJJJ (NSPS) if applicable.

Since the engine is ≤ 500 HP and was manufactured prior to July 1, 2008, it is not subject to any substantive requirements in 40CFR60 Subpart JJJJ (NSPS).

The potential emissions for the engine are as follows:

RECOMMENDATION:

The emission rates are below the emission limits of six (6) lb/hr and ten (10) TPY; 2 lb/hr, or 5 TPY of HAPs set forth set forth in 45CSR13 - 2.17.a&b. Therefore, a permit is not required by this Division for the installation and operation of the above mentioned emergency generator.
