It has been determined that a class II administrative update to your existing permit will be required under 45CSR13 for your proposed modification of a bulk terminal. This determination is based on information included with your permit determination form dated June 13, 2016, which indicates that **uncontrolled** emissions from the ammonium nitrate transfer operations exceed 6 pounds per hour and 10 tons per year of PM. Specifically, please note that for permit determination purposes emissions must be calculated based on no air pollution control devices being used.
