Dear Mr. Sweeney:

It has been determined that a permit will not be required for the proposed replacement of a 4MMBtu/hr natural gas fired boiler with a 3.68 MMBtu/hr natural gas fired boiler at the above referenced station. This determination is based on information included with your Permit Determination Form (PDF) received on April 13, 2016, which indicates that the increase in emissions will not exceed two (2) lbs/hr or five (5) tons/year of total Hazardous Air Pollutants (HAPs); six (6) lbs/hour and ten (10) TPY of any regulated pollutant; or, trigger a substantive requirement of any State or Federal air quality regulation.

Please bear in mind, however, that any additional changes to the proposed facility, may require a permit under 45CSR13. Furthermore, pursuant to 45CSR13-5.14, records briefly describing the proposed change, the pollutants involved, the potential to emit for each pollutant increased or added shall be maintained by the owner or operator for at least two years and made available to the Director upon request.
