Dear Mr. Fehrenbacher:

It has been determined that a Class II Administrative Update will be required under 45CSR13 for your proposed process change to empty Methyl Methacrylate from the existing MMA storage tank to empty chemical trailers. This would increase emissions of VOC's and HAP's of 0.85 lbs/hr and 0.0253 TPY. 45CSR13-4.2.b.1 requires a Class II administrative update to "Change a permit condition as necessary, to allow changes in...operating parameters...which results in an increase or no change in the emission of any existing regulated air pollutant..." Additional requirements to your R13-0181D permit would be added to require submerged fill and minimizing air emissions, as well as the number of cleanings and number of chemical trailers to be used during this process.

Please bear in mind, however, that any additional changes to the proposed facility may require a permit under 45CSR13. Furthermore, pursuant to 45CSR13-5.14, records briefly describing the proposed change, the pollutants involved, the potential to emit for each pollutant increased or added shall be maintained by the owner or operator for at least two years and made available to the Director upon request.
