

## Notice of Intent to Approve Class II General Permit G70-A for Natural Gas Production Facilities Located at the Well Site

The West Virginia Department of Environmental Protection Division of Air Quality (DAQ) is providing notice to the general public of its intent to issue a Class II General Permit for the prevention and control of air pollution in regard to the construction, modification, relocation, administrative update and operation of natural gas production facilities located at the well site pursuant to WV Legislative Rule 45CSR13.

Provided that the applicant or registrant can demonstrate compliance with the requirements, provisions, standards and conditions of this Class II General Permit, the DAQ has determined that all state air quality requirements will be met by any eligible natural gas production facility. Any natural gas production facility granted a Class II General Permit registration by the Director shall not have a potential to emit an amount equal to or greater than 100 tons per year of any criteria pollutant or 10 tons per year of any single hazardous/toxic pollutant or 25 tons per year of any combination of hazardous/toxic pollutants.

The public may provide written comments regarding this DRAFT Class II General Permit to the Division of Air Quality. **All written comments or requests for a public meeting must be received by the DAQ before 5:00 p.m. on Monday, April 29, 2013.** Based upon the significance of any written comments received addressing the subject of this notice, the Director of the DAQ may elect to hold a public meeting to receive further public comment. Prior to taking any final action on this permitting issue, the DAQ will consider only those written comments relevant to air quality issues which this Division has jurisdiction. Such written comments must be received within the specified time frame and at the address below.

This notice provides an opportunity for the public to review the DRAFT Class II General Permit G70-A and Engineering Evaluation. In the event you wish to submit written comments, include your name, a return address, and a daytime telephone number and indicate any organization on behalf of which your comments are submitted. If, in your written comment you request that a public meeting be held to discuss this permitting action, please state the specific air quality issue(s) which you feel requires additional evaluation by this Division. All public comments are a part of the public record and are available for inspection by any interested party.
