Dear Mr. Murphy:

It has been determined that the Nitro Storage Facility located in Nitro, Putnam County, WV is not defined, pursuant to 45CSR13, as a "stationary source." This determination is based on the information in your Permit Determination Form (PDF) submitted on March 2, 2015. This information indicates that the facility does not have a reasonably calculated maximum potential to discharge over two (2) lbs/hr OR five (5) tons/year of total Hazardous Air Pollutants (HAPs); six (6) lbs/hour AND ten (10) TPY or one hundred forty-four (144) pounds per calendar day of any regulated pollutant; or trigger a substantive requirement of any State or Federal air quality regulation.

Please be aware that any future changes to the facility may trigger the requirement to obtain a permit under 45CSR13 by defining the facility as a "stationary source."
