Cranberry Pipeline Corporation is submitting this Class I Administrative Permit Application Letter to address a needed administrative change within the newly issued General Permit G35-A Registration for the Rich Creek Compressor Station (ID. 099-00091). The changes within Rich Creek's Emission Limitations table on page 4 within the registration to modify involve correcting the second "Source ID" listing from "CE-1" to "CE-2" and that corresponding "Emissions Source" from "White Superior 8GTLB" to "White Superior 6GTLB". Another change on the same page is the annual VOCs for RSV-1 which needs to be changed from "49.02" to "25.76". The typos are thought to have been made on the agency's part since the application that was submitted identified the aforementioned changes within the application.
