Dear Mr. Michaud:

It has been determined that a permit will not be required under 45CSR13 for your proposed modification of a natural gas plant. This determination is based on information included with your permit determination form dated April 23, 2015 and received on April 24, 2015, which indicates that the increase in emissions will not exceed two (2) lbs/hr OR five (5) tons/year of total Hazardous Air Pollutants (HAPs); six (6) lbs/hour AND ten (10) TPY of any regulated pollutant; or, trigger a substantive requirement of any State or Federal air quality regulation.

This permit determination is for a like-for-like replacement of a Waukesha P9390GSI internal combustion engine (S/N 5283701326) with an engine of identical make and model (S/N 5253704116).

Please bear in mind, however, that any additional changes to the proposed facility may require a permit under 45CSR13. Furthermore, pursuant to 45CSR13-5.14, records briefly describing the proposed change, the pollutants involved, the potential to emit for each pollutant increased or added shall be maintained by the owner or operator for at least two years and made available to the Director upon request.
