It has been determined that a permit will not be required under 45CSR13 for the addition of two new surface coatings (Temperkote No. 888 Primer & Temperkote No. 888) at the above referenced facility. This determination is based on information included with your Permit Determination Form (PDF) received on April 4, 2016, which indicates that although the increase in emissions will not exceed two (2) lbs/hr or five (5) tons/year of total Hazardous Air Pollutants (HAPs); six (6) lbs/hour and ten (10) TPY of any regulated pollutant; or, trigger a substantive requirement of any State or Federal air quality regulation, there is an emissions increase. This Division recommends that the applicant complete the forms necessary for a Class II Administrative Update of Permit R13-1364G in order to incorporate the new additions in the permit.
