**Subject: Notification of Caterpillar G3516B Engine Replacement in Kind
Williams Ohio Valley Midstream LLC
Pinecone Compressor Station (Permit R13-3179)
Marshall County, West Virginia**

Dear Ms. McKeone:

Williams Ohio Valley Midstream LLC (Williams OVM) is submitting this letter to notify the West Virginia Department of Environmental Protection, Division of air quality of an engine replacement in kind at the Pinecone Compressor Station located in Marshall County. One of the Caterpillar G3516B compressor engines recently caught fire and was replaced with an identical unit on November 14, 2015.

The engine change is a "replacement in kind" as the existing emission unit was replaced with an identical emission unit with the same model number, horsepower, torque and emissions specifications. Additionally, the air pollution control device has the same specifications as the original equipment.

The old engine with serial number JEF01687 was replaced by an identical unit with serial number N6E00294 and manufacture date of May 2015. Note there is no change in regulatory applicability as the old and new engines are both subject to the requirements of NSPS Subpart JJJJ. Williams OVM will conduct performance testing on the new Caterpillar G3516B compressor engine as required under NSPS Subpart JJJJ.
