Dear Mr. Fleming:

It has been determined that a permit will be required under 45CSR13 for your 138,600 gallon storage tank containing a petroleum crude oil solution at the above referenced facility. This determination is based on information included with your permit determination form (PDF) received on September 28, 2015, which indicates that although the emissions will not exceed two (2) lbs/hr or five (5) tons/year of total Hazardous Air Pollutants (HAPs); six (6) lbs/hour and ten (10) TPY of any regulated pollutant, the tank does, however, trigger a substantive requirement of a federal air quality regulation, namely, 40CFR60 subpart Kb, §60.112b(b)(2).

Submit the completed forms, \$1,000.00 permit application fee, and any other applicable fees to the above address.
