Dear Mr. Valvo:

It has been determined that the addition of a paint booth, bead blasting unit, and welding hood to the facility meets the "de minimis" source definition of 45CSR13 Table 45-13B and that a permit will not be required under 45CSR13. It has also been determined that this equipment is considered an "insignificant source" for Title V Purposes. The solvent metal cleaning source (Z331-4) has an increase of emissions less than 6 lbs/hr and 10 tons per year or more, or more than 144 pounds per calendar day of VOC's, so a permit will not be required under 45CSR13. This source will be required to be added to the R30-10700001-2011 Title V Permit to include 45CSR21 Section 30 requirements. This determination is based on information included with your permit determination form dated November 18, 2015 and received on November 20, 2015, which indicates that there will be an insignificant increase of VOC's; no increase in Hazardous Air Pollutants (HAPs); or any other regulated pollutant; or, trigger a substantive requirement of any State or Federal air quality regulation.

Please bear in mind, however, that any additional changes to the proposed facility may require a permit under 45CSR13. Furthermore, pursuant to 45CSR13-5.14, records briefly describing the proposed change, the pollutants involved, the potential to emit for each pollutant increased or added shall be maintained by the owner or operator for at least two years and made available to the Director upon request.
