Subject: G35-A016A—Enervest Operating, Clear Fork Compressor Station

On August 7, 2015, Enervest submitted a Class II Administrative Update application to the West Virginia Division of Air Quality (DAQ) to review the proposed removal of two (2) Caterpillar G3516 TALE compressor engines and the addition of one (1) G3512 TALE and one (1) G3508TALE.

The emissions change associated with this change are represented in the following table:

Pollutant	Emission Change (lb/hr)	Emission Change (tpy)
Nitrogen Oxides	-3.23	-14.15
Carbon Monoxide	+1.23	+5.38
Volatile Organic Compounds	+0.22	+0.97

Due to the emissions increase of less than 6 lbs/hr and 10 tons/yr, this permitting action qualifies for a Class II administrative update. Enervest paid the required administrative update fee and published a legal ad in *The Register Herald* on September 21, 2015.

Since the changes will result in emissions less than modification thresholds and Enervest has supplied the required information, it is the writers opinion that Enervest be granted this Class II Administrative Update.
