Dear Mr. Hill:

It has been determined that a modification to your permit will not be required under 45CSR13 for your proposed replacement in-kind of Tanks 13-14 with Tanks 11-12. It is understood that there will be a change of PM and VOC emissions due to recalculating the emissions from EPA's AP-42 factors to a more accurate use of EPA's Tanks 4.09 software application. This determination is based on information submitted with your permit determination form dated October 21, 2016 and received on October 24, 2016, which indicates that the increase in emissions will not exceed two (2) lbs/hr OR five (5) tons/year of total Hazardous Air Pollutants (HAPs); six (6) lbs/hour OR ten (10) TPY of any regulated pollutant; or, trigger a substantive requirement of any State or Federal air quality regulation.

Please bear in mind, however, that any additional changes to the proposed facility may require a permit under 45CSR13.
