On August 3, 2015, the DAQ received information from Antero considering emissions from: six (6) 0.5-mmBtu/hr GPU heaters and two (2) 400-bbl produced liquid tanks. This evaluation will examine the potential permit applicability under 45CSR13.

Investigation

This exact equipment at this facility was determined to require a permit in PD14-079 issued on January 16, 2015. The DAQ is aware that Antero has returned the CTO for Male Station and stated that the facility has been shut down. However, until Antero requests that permit registration G30-D171 be made inactive and demonstrates to DAQ's Compliance and Enforcement Section that the compressor station portion of this facility has been permanently shutdown; the DAQ considers the source active and operating. Therefore, the determination issued under PD14-079 stands.

Recommendation

Based on the information provided and the currently active permit registration G30-D171 the recommendation of the writer is that a permit is currently required from Antero Resources Corporation for Male Wellpad.
