Dear Mr. Schatz,

It has been determined that a permit is required under 45CSR13 for this facility. This determination is based on information included with the permit determination form received August 3, 2015 and other active permits for this facility.

This exact equipment at this facility was determined to require a permit in PD14-079 issued on January 16, 2015. The DAQ is aware that Antero has returned the CTO for Male Station and stated that the facility has been shut down. However, until Antero requests that permit registration G30-D171 be made inactive and demonstrates to DAQ's Compliance and Enforcement Section that the compressor station portion of this facility has been permanently shutdown; the DAQ considers the source active and operating. Therefore, the determination issued under PD14-079 stands.
