Dear Mr. Schmittiel:

It has been determined that a permit will not be required under 45CSR13 for your proposed construction of a portable crusher. This determination is based on information included with your permit determination form dated August 07, 2015 and received on August 11, 2015, which indicates that the potential to emit will not exceed two (2) lbs/hr of any Hazardous Air Pollutant (HAP) OR five (5) tons/year of aggregated Hazardous Air Pollutants; six (6) lbs/hour AND ten (10) TPY of any regulated air pollutant; or, trigger a substantive requirement of any State or Federal air quality regulation.

Please bear in mind, however, that any additional changes to the proposed facility may require a permit under 45CSR13. Furthermore, pursuant to 45CSR13-5.14, records briefly describing the proposed change, the pollutants involved, the potential to emit for each pollutant increased or added shall be maintained by the owner or operator for at least two years and made available to the Director upon request.
