Your Permit Determination Form (PDF) was received by this Division on August 7, 2015, and assigned to the writer for review. Upon initial review of said PDF and conversations on August 27, 2015 with Michael Dearing from your company, it has been determined that the PDF as submitted is incomplete and no decision can be made based on the following item:

- The PDF contained conflicting engine manufacturer's date documentation (mm/dd/yyyy) that the Ford CSG-649 engine at the WPHC-209 station was manufactured. This engine is proposed to replace the existing Caterpillar G3304 engine. This item is required to determine 40CFR60 Subpart JJJJ applicability.
