**CONDUCTING CONSTRUCTION AND DEMOLITION
ACTIVITIES WITHOUT A PROPER ASBESTOS
INSPECTION IS AGAINST THE LAW!!**

Asbestos may be found in many materials associated with construction and demolition activities, such as:

- cementitious roofing & siding shingles
- floor tiles & mastic
- thermal system insulation
- glue-on and drop ceiling tiles
- plaster
- silver roofing paint
- window glazing compound
- roofing materials & mastic
- linoleum

It's against the law to do the following activities without an asbestos inspection:

- Construction*
- Demolition
- Remodeling
- Renovation

** Note - New Construction which does not tie into or disturb an existing facility does not require an asbestos inspection*

KEY POINTS

- **All Construction, Demolition and Renovation Activities Require Inspection**
- **Send a Notification of Abatement, Demolition or Renovation Form to DAQ & BPH**
- **A Copy of the Inspection Report is to be Attached to the Notification Form**
- **There is a 10 Working Day Waiting Period Associated with the Notification**
