

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING CANCELLATION

In the January 13, 2012 *West Virginia Register*, the West Virginia Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) announced an opportunity for a public hearing on a proposed revision to the State Implementation Plan (SIP) regarding the 2008 8-hour ozone National Ambient Air Quality Standards (NAAQS). In this proposed revision to the SIP, West Virginia is demonstrating that it has adequate resources and authority to implement the 2008 8-hour ozone NAAQS. Compliance with specific CAA section 110(a)(2) requirements is detailed in a document demonstrating that the State meets these express requirements through authorities granted under state laws and regulations, as well as implementation of existing air programs. DEP sought comments on whether the document adequately demonstrates West Virginia's compliance with the pertinent federal CAA mandates related to these so-called infrastructure elements. The public comment period began January 13, 2012 and ended February 13, 2012. No person requested a public hearing. Therefore the public hearing tentatively scheduled for February 21, 2012 is hereby cancelled.
